Nov. 12: Nanjing International Arts Festival Begins

In just its third year of existence, this three month-long festival is one of the newer additions to China's burgeoning contemporary art world. Set within the eye-catching Baijia Lake International Culture Center, this year's edition is organized around the theme "Historicode," which explores the evolution of the art market, ideas of art history, and standards for art criticism, and how all have affected art and artists globally since the 1990s. Over four hundred international artists will be represented through more than 800 works, including pieces by Asian stars like Qiu Anxiong, Lee Changwon, Zeng Fanzhi and Yue Minjun; visitors to the city (the capital of affluent Jiangsu province, outside Shanghai) can also explore its Art Museum of Nanjing University of the Arts and the private Sifang Art Museum while in town. *Baijia Lake Museum, Nanjing, China; njiaf.com.*
