## Midcentury Oasis in Palm Springs, California

**The Lautner**, a four-room property named after prolific 20th-century architect John Lautner, has been lovingly restored in recent years with classic design elements and modern comforts, including en suite kitchenettes, outdoor lounge areas, a grilling station, saline plunge pool, and fire pits and market lighting for after-dark ambiance.

Concierge services are available by phone 24/7 and can readily assist with scheduling on-site spa treatments, private yoga or fitness instructors, even catering services or a private chef. While all of Palm Springs is in your backyard, there's a serious chance you might never want to leave the grounds of this luxe desert retreat.

## Modern Luxury Overlooking the Pacific

The Central American country of El Salvador is full of surprises, one of them being **B Boutique Hotel**, a four-room, villa-style property that's built into black rock cliffs high above the Pacific Ocean. Sunny days and moderate temps year-round (highs in the 70s and 80s) mean that no matter what time of year you're planning your bachelorette, everyone will *love* having a private infinity pool and these gorgeous ocean views for the weekend.

Attentive staff will make sure the rosé stays chilled, can arrange for private dining experiences in your villa, airport transportation (a 30-minute ride), and can connect you with local tour companies if you'd like to check out some of El Salvador's other treasures, including lush national parks, artisan workshops and coffee plantations, and more gorgeous beaches, of course.

## Your Very Own Parisian Pied-à-Terre

As Audrey Hepburn once said, "Paris is always a good idea." We happen to agree, and fortunately, **Paris Perfect** has a few fabulous flats that would indeed be perfect for a bachelorette fete heading to the City of Light. One of our favorites is the **Margaux** apartment in the 7th Arrondissement, which comfortably sleeps six to eight, and comes with a full kitchen, living room and dining room, as well as a wraparound terrace with *this* view.

But what really sets Paris Perfect apart is its next-level guest services, including pretravel itinerary planning, restaurant reservations (this is a big plus for groups of any size) and a lengthy list of bespoke experiences and tours on offer, from private cooking classes, to exclusive museum access, to city tours after dark. When you're planning a group event like a bachelorette from afar, this sort of access to local resources is game changing.

If so, what could be better than heading home to your private, Balinese-style lodge after a killer afternoon surf session to catch the sunset and unwind with your besties while dinner is prepared by your personal executive chef? **Kalon Surf** was designed with just such experiences in mind.

Located on six acres of rainforest and jungle trails near prime surfing beaches along Costa Rica's southern coast, booking your bachelorette at Kalon Surf means every detail is attended to from the moment you arrive at San Jose airport. The all-inclusive rate includes round-trip airport transportation, customized daily surf coaching, pilates, one massage per guest and all meals daily—gourmet fare made from locally sourced ingredients and fresh, seasonal produce, including ingredients sourced on the grounds. Bridal beauty goals? Check!

**JUST Inn**, a four-suite boutique offering on the grounds of Justin Vineyards & Winery, is an ideal overnight for brides planning a winery tour of California's Central Coast. The rooms feature fireplaces, hydro-spa tubs, Frette linens, among other cozy touches, and all reservations include a cave tour, wine tasting and breakfast in the morning. The winery's restaurant earns high marks for its wine cellar and farm-to-table cuisine; whether you opt for à la carte ordering or go all in with the five-course tasting menu, there's no better way to end the day than with some stargazing around the fire pits, the grounds of the vineyard all your own.

If you've found yourself scouring Airbnb for listings would somehow, miraculously, keep everyone together under one roof, we've got fab alternative for you.

**Oasis** is a home-sharing site similar to Airbnb, but with a few major differences. All homes are vetted before they can join; check-in and housekeeping services are handled professionally; and Oasis offers guests a ton of perks, including on-demand concierge services, a bevy of VIP exclusives (we're partial to priority reservations and a **kitchen tour** of one of Mario Batali's restaurants), and complimentary access to a local member's only club, such as Norwood in New York City. This summer, Oasis is launching a few new amenities, including a "stock up" option. What's not to love about chocolate and Champagne ready and awaiting your arrival?

The historic home of author and cultural icon Ian Fleming, where many legendary Bond lines were penned, the Fleming Villa is now a luxurious private retreat complete with its own private beach, pool, gardens and staff who can arrange for private dinners at the villa, catamaran excursions, spa services, whatever your idea of the ultimate Bond Girl bachelorette entails.

Fleming himself was known for throwing lavish affairs at his Caribbean estate, so you know the property is bachelorette ready. In total, the Fleming Villa features five bedrooms—three in the main house and two in cottages on site—as well as a full kitchen, media room and bar with plenty of vintage details, natch.
