6. China

Best fall off-season destination for: Nature and city-seekers alike

If you're hoping to check somewhere in Asia off your bucket list, Dave and Deb from [The Planet D](#) recommend getting out of Shanghai to visit another city like [Suzhou](#) during the off-season for a multi-day adventure. They recommend Suzhou for "*an immersive experience into Chinese culture, history, and artistry, Suzhou is a must-stop on any China itinerary.*"

Suzhou is sometimes referred to as the 'Venice of the East' because it is a "*historic city filled with canals, UNESCO World Heritage designated classical gardens and ancient pedestrian streets.*" However even in the off-season, popular gardens like the [Humble Administrator's Garden](#), [Lion Grove Garden](#), and [Tiger Hill](#) can be busy with local tourists, so you'll want to arrive as close to opening as possible to wander through with a smaller crowd.
